

## Carbon Reduction Plan

*(Compliant with UK Government PPN 006 Requirements)*

### 1. Commitment to Achieve Net Zero

This is Jungle Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, in line with the UK Government’s Net Zero target.

As a London-centric interior fit-out contractor, Jungle recognises that the majority of emissions associated with its activities occur within its supply chain and construction materials. Our carbon reduction strategy therefore focuses on improving operational efficiency while engaging suppliers to reduce embodied carbon across projects.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been developed in accordance with PPN 006 requirements for suppliers bidding for UK public sector contracts, including NHS procurement frameworks.

### 2. Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: **2025**

2025 has been adopted as Jungle’s operational baseline year following significant growth in the business.

Turnover (2025): **£5.29m**

Carbon intensity metric: **272.07 total emissions (tCO<sub>2</sub>e) per £1m revenue**

This intensity metric will be used to track reductions over time.

### 3. Emissions Reduction Targets

Jungle has adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

Year	Target
2025	Baseline year established
2029	30% reduction in carbon intensity
2035	40% reduction in carbon intensity
2040	60% reduction in carbon intensity
2050	Net Zero operations

Carbon intensity reductions will be achieved through operational efficiency and supply chain engagement.

### 4. Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following measures have been implemented or are planned to reduce emissions.

#### Operational Efficiency

Jungle operates a deliberately **London-centric delivery model**, reducing long-distance travel associated with UK fit-out projects.

Operational measures include:

- Warehouse located in **St Albans (18 miles from Central London)** to minimise logistics travel
- Clustering of projects to reduce travel requirements
- Asset-light fleet strategy, avoiding unnecessary vehicle ownership
- Adoption of **electric vehicles where operationally viable**

#### Travel & Transport

Actions include:

- Prioritising rail travel over domestic flights
- Reducing operational travel through project planning
- Continued transition of management vehicles to electric alternatives where practical

#### Materials & Supply Chain

Given that embodied carbon within construction materials is a key source of emissions in the fit-out sector, Jungle will focus on:

- Supplier ESG screening and annual questionnaires

- Engagement with key suppliers on material carbon data
- Increased use of recycled and low-impact materials where feasible
- Waste reduction through improved project planning

## Waste Management

Jungle works with licensed waste contractors and aims to achieve:

**≥95% waste diversion from landfill across projects where data is available.**

## Governance & Monitoring

To ensure progress against carbon targets:

- Carbon emissions will be calculated annually
- Carbon intensity will be tracked against revenue
- Supplier ESG screening will form part of Jungle's approved supplier framework
- ESG performance will be reviewed annually by the Board

## 5. Future Commitments

As the business grows and reporting capability improves, Jungle will continue to enhance carbon measurement and reduction activities, including:

- Improved supply chain carbon reporting
- Greater use of environmental product data where available
- Ongoing engagement with subcontractors to support sector-wide decarbonisation

## 6. Declaration

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with **PPN 006** and associated guidance for public sector procurement.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the GHG Reporting Protocol Corporate Standard and using the UK Government's GHG Conversion Factors for Company Reporting.
